JUNE 10, 11 & 12 - TOILET BLOCK CLEANING/PAVILION:

There are two (2) toilets blocks at the grounds which require cleaning and maintenance two times a day on these dates. With an additional set of Toilets to be cleaned in the Pavilion twice a day also.

JUNE 13, 14, 15, 16 - TOILET BLOCK CLEANING/PAVILION:

- There are four (4) toilet blocks in total, which require cleaning and maintenance during the Show weekend at the Showgrounds three times a day on these dates, including the pavilion.
- The Pavilion is to be swept and mopped prior to the Pavilion opening both Friday and Saturday morning and every 4-6 hours during the show days.
- On each cleaning round of the Pavilion toilets, the Pavilion floor is to be swept under the instruction of the Pavilion coordinator. Please speak to the Pavilion coordinator or Steward onsite to check if any issues have occured.
- The required hand towels and toilet paper are provided by Cloncurry Shire Council
- Successful applicants will be required to provide their own gloves, chemicals, mops, brooms, brushes, hoses and any other products required to complete the job.
- Toilets are to be cleaned after 4pm Thursday, ready for the gates to open 9am Friday morning.
- The toilet blocks as well as the Pavilion floor, are to be cleaned **Monday morning June 16**, ready for the handover back to the Cloncurry Shire Council Monday afternoon.

June 13 - CATTLEMEN'S EVENING EVENT 6:30pm - 12am

Prior to 11am for handover back to the Cloncurry Shire Council on Saturday June 14, all areas of use for the event including toilet facilities / courtyard / precinct function rooms / bar require cleaning and removal of excess rubbish after the completion of the event.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- There should be two (2) people contactable by phone at all times for emergency clean ups.
- Security Passes for entry into the show can be obtained prior to the Show from the Show Office.
- A roster of cleaning staff should be made available to the Show Society prior to the commencement of the Show, so that gate passes can be arranged.
- The successful tender should meet with the Show Society prior to the show to address any concerns or clarify any issues either party may have.
- Workplace health and safety guidelines must be adhered to at all times, protective clothing such as long sleeved shirt, gloves, sunscreen, closed in shoes and wide brim hat to be worn as required.
- No personal vehicles are to be bought on to the showgrounds during the duration of the show without prior consultation.
